This 'eggstraordinary' event sees 200 very special eggs hidden across the streets of the capital, and now the hunt is on. How many can you find? You'll have to look hard though - some of them are hidden in 'eggsceptional' places!

You can find 10 of these stunning and unique eggs in the Carnaby area. The eggs have been designed, bejewelled and decorated by some of the world's leading artists, architects, jewellers and designers. Eggs in Carnaby include Benjamin Shine's 'Egg Letter Box'; a bright red take on the classic London post box, Vincent McEvoy's 'My Generation' egg which is painted with lyrics from The Who classic song 'My Generation' and a beautiful oriental print egg by fashion designer Daisuke Sakaguchi.



Discover the eggs in Carnaby Street, Newburgh Street, Broadwick Street and Kingly Court. Top tip - look up as well as down! Download a map indicating the locations of all of the eggs in the area [here](#).

The hand-crafted eggs, which are destined to become highly collectible works of art will be in place until April, then will be available to buy at auction in London in April, with proceeds going to Action for Children and Elephant Family.
