The hotel has celebrated his arrival with a dedicated egg menu of dishes such as Egg Soldiers, Mini Scotch Eggs and an exclusive Eggs Fabergé option. He was designed by Rachel Waldron and reflected two of her favourite things - cavalry and dipping soldiers in eggs. Other designs include Benjamin Shin's 'Egg Letter Box' and Vincent McEvoy's 'My Generation'.
