In addition, the event organisers are hoping to break not one, but two Guinness World Records. The first for the most participants in an Easter egg hunt and the second for the world's most expensive chocolate egg, designed by William Curley.

We'll be keeping an eye out for Rachel Waldron's cute soldier egg, as well as artist Benjamin Shine's red post-box egg, which is designed to function as a real letterbox.
